

Court Monitors

Court monitors are volunteers and will do their best to resolve any disputes that may arise. Treat them with respect. Any mistreatment of the court monitors and you will be disqualified.

<u>Division Details</u> – There will be male and female divisions with age groups as follows. A team with players in multiple age levels, will play in the bracket of the oldest player.

• Juniors: 10 & under, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-18.

• Adult: 19-29, 30-39, 40 & over.

<u>Information / Eligibility</u>

- 1. Each team must have four players on their roster and be registered by the entry deadline. Additions or changes will not be permitted after the entry deadline.
- 2. Players may only be on one roster for each tournament.
- 3. Teams will be split into male and female divisions based on average age, experience and height of players. Co-ed teams will be placed into the male division, using the same criteria.
- 4. Identification for each player is required at on-site registration to verify the information provided on the application. ID can include driver's license for those of age, birth certificates or other ID for those not of driving age.
- 5. If any of a player's personal information (e.g. age, height, experience) listed on the application is found to be inaccurate, the player will be eliminated from participation in the tournament. If information of a player is discovered to be false after registration, it may result in the elimination of the whole team.
- 6. If there are eligibility problems, enforcement will take place from the point of discovery. Games or brackets will not be replayed.
- 7. For disqualification due to eligibility problems, NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR ANY REASON!

RULES

- 1. A made basket from inside the arc is worth 1 point.
- 2. A made basket from behind the line is worth 2 points. Both feet must be behind the line when initiating the shot.
- 3. Games will be to 15 points, win by 2, up to a max of 20 points.
- 4. Games will have a 25 minute time limit. Time will not "run" during a timeout.
- 5. If a game takes 25 minutes, the team that is ahead at that time will be declared the winner. If it is tied at the 25 minute mark, next basket wins.

TIMEOUTS / SUBSTITUTIONS

- 1. Each team will have one 1 minute time-out per game.
- 2. If play is stopped for an injury, the injured player must sit out at least until the next dead ball.
- 3. Player substitution is permitted during any dead ball situation.
